

We have put here the wonderous story In writing, in pictures, and song All things that brought us glory, Events that went right and went wrong.



And his little brother, Clyde, although skinny as a bean, From what he's already shone us is the answer to a coach's dream.


And there's Dan Severn, who if you'd let him kick a point, Would just be tickled pink,

And if he missed, he'd come back to the bench and say, "Golly, coach, I stink."


And there is ole Melvin, our manager, Who was as hardheaded as a bull. But when anything needed doing Ole Melvin could really pull.

Except to repeat, "They're certainly a swell bunch of fellows Out Buda way."




