With a broken collar bone.

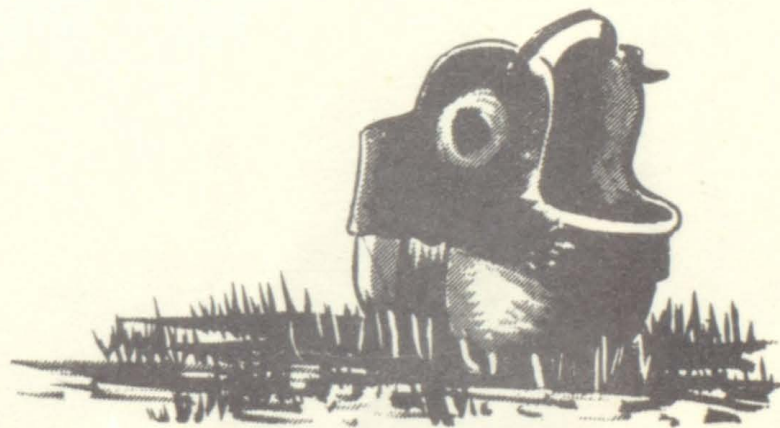
No, I haven't forgotten ole Bobby Jack,

"Golly, coach, I stink."

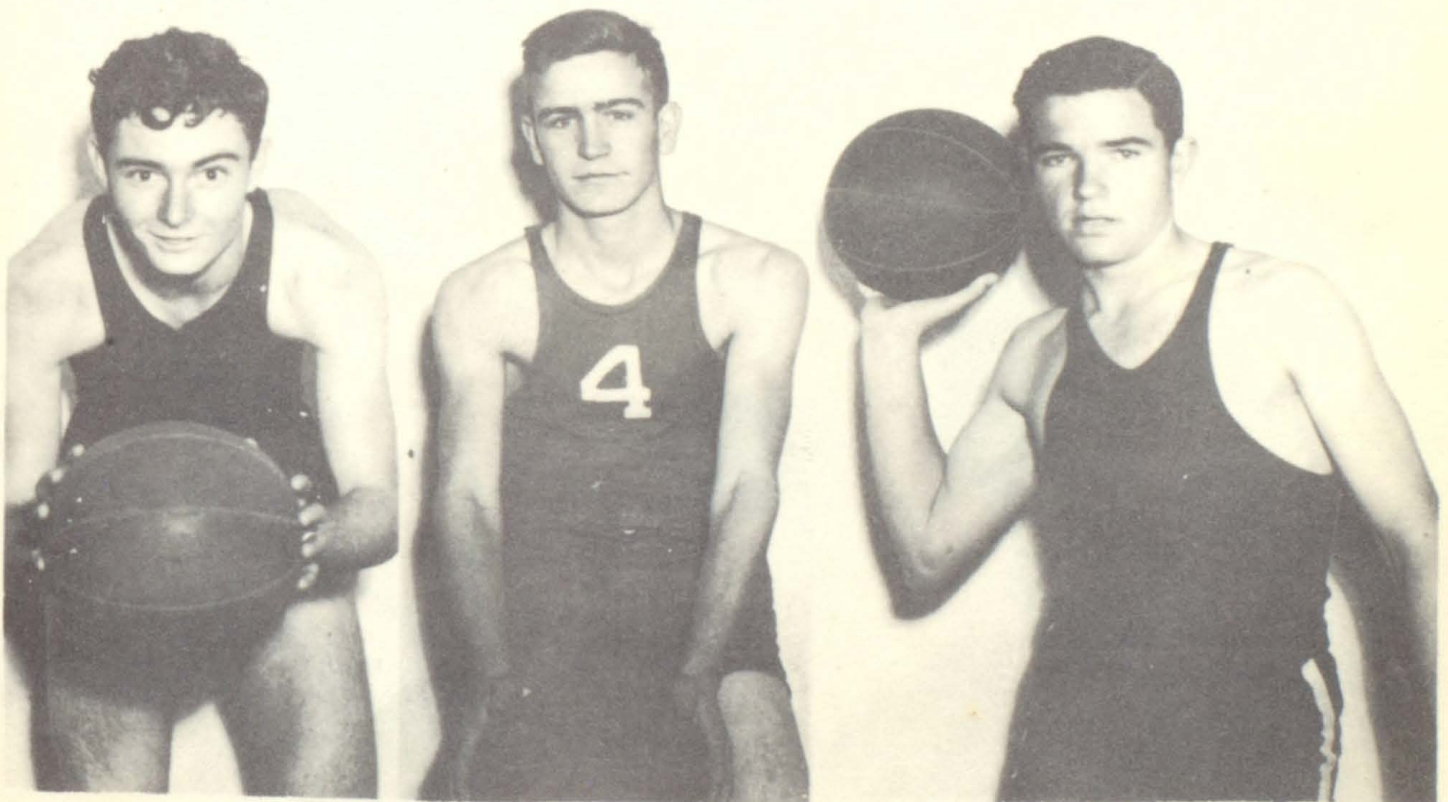
And there is ole Melvin, our manager,
