BUDA FANS PROUD OF CHAMP BULLDOGS

Buda Wins Regional Six-Man Title, Beat Norton 57 to 27

Buda Mento Coach of Year

From a diamond in the rough to a glittering jewel might be the phrase which describes Buda High School's Bulldog District 11 and Region 3 six man football champions of 1955. The Hays County football squad was largely inexperienced in those sweltering days of September when it first stepped for practice—but the Bulldogs could probably compare with any six man football team in Texas the night of December 2 in Austin's House Park when it crushed Norton High School's Eagles, 57-27, for the regional championship.

Behind that success story lies several hidden facts. The Bulldogs were never overconfident—for a 38-13 thrashing by 1949 regional champion Dripping Springs in the season opener took care of that—and Manor's talented Mustangs followed up with a 36-20 triumph later in the season.

Perhaps the most solid reason of all was a genial little man who had never before won a championship—but who worked like a demon throughout the season as Buda sought its first football crown since 1938.

Buda captured the crown on the night of Nov. 17 in Buda when it turned the tables on defending district and regional champion Dripping Springs, 28-18—and with that victory, Coach L. B. Owen earned Coach of the Year honors in Central Texas.

He had to beat out some wise and experienced mentors—but after that victory over Dripping Springs, and Buda's march into the regional title it had never before won—well, you just had to stick with the Southwest Texas State College product.

Buda Beats Dripping Springs to Win Title

District 11 Team

Buda's Bulldogs sacked up the District 11 six-man football championship Friday night by outscoring the defending champions from Dripping Springs 26 to 18.

Buda tallied 255 points to 121 for the opposition this season.

Buda Sexte In Regional

Six man football fans in Austin for the second straight year, will have an opportunity to see the Region 3 championship clash this week.

At 8 p.m. Saturday game in House Park between Buda Bulldogs, champion of District 11, and Norton's Eagles, winner of District 9, will determine who succeeds Dripping Springs High School's Tiger as regional champion.

Buda won bidistrict honor Saturday at House Park by edging Harper's Bobcats of District 12, 31-30. Norton's defeated Comyn, of District 33-18, Thursday at Ballinger for its bidistrict conquest. It will be the second straight year teams from Districts 11 and 9 have collided for regional honors. Dripping Springs thumped Motel (Fisk), 25-6, last year at House Park in the regional final.

Kyle To Host Buda In Six-Man Contest

Buda Crushes Blanco In First Two Quarters

BUDA, Sept. 22.—(AP)—Scoring was done in the quarters in this District game as Buda's Bulldogs crushed Blanco's Panthers, 20-6.

Blanco took a short-lived lead when Birdie Broderick passed 40 yards to Bob Calhoun. Then Jim Brewington raced 65 yards and Teet Rodriguez passed five yards to Marvin Thames, and Ronald Armbruster hit Thames for five yards in the second period to put Buda ahead. Thames and Rodriguez scored the extra points.

Buda's Bulldogs copped the Region 3 Six-Man football title Saturday night by scoring an overwhelming 57 to 27 triumph over Norton's Eagles.

The game, played in Austin's House Park, carried the faint tint of an upset as Coach L. B. Owen's Bulldogs stole the show from favored Norton. Even so, the Buda team had to take to the air, and a passing battle that led to a strong finish by Buda was the result. The Bulldogs completed 15 passes out of 23 attempts, with six of the aeriels counting for touchdowns. Meanwhile, Norton's Frankie Taylor, quarterback, completed 17 out of 37 passing attempts.
