To serve: Use one-fifth glass of this syrup and fill with ice and water. For a punch bowl, add 4 quarts of water and ice to 1 quart of punch syrup. Serves about 25. For a delicious change, when mixed in punch bowl, add about 16 oz. of grapefruit juice or grape or orange or pineapple juice.
