I acknowledge that Hays CISD uses an Internet filter and will monitor traffic on district-owned iPads and Chromebooks. The filter will detect and report inappropriate access, potential threats, cyberbullying, and self-harm. Students that use a personal device, but still log into g.hayscisd domain, will also be monitored and filtered. Note that if other family members use the district-owned devices, their traffic will be also be monitored and reported by default.

Technology Usage at School

Hays CISD uses Google's G-Suite for Education (formerly Apps for Education). All 8th – 12th grade students automatically receive a google account when the student's computer account is created. Students in 7th grade and under receive a google account ONLY if permission is granted below.

The online tools included in G-Suite greatly enhance your student's ability to access, collaborate, and share what they learn in school. The following is a brief peek at the G-Suite tools and apps your child may have access to utilize:

- Google Drive An online collaborative file storage system.
- Google Slides For creating presentations.
- Google Docs For writing and researching papers.
- Google Sheets For collecting, sorting, and organizing data.
- Google Classroom Blended learning environment set up by teachers that works with Google Drive.
- Google Calendar An online tool used to create or share important dates or events.
- Gmail For students in 8th grade and up only.
- Google Sites A website design tool.
