Agenda:

1) Potential point system for accidents typed and given to Cassandra for review:

Avoidable Accidents (Ex. tree limb breaks a window, hits a parked car, etc.)

First Offense

- Bus to Object (tree, mailbox, etc.): 2 pts and a counsel
- Bus to Vehicle: 3 pts and refresher training
- Bus to Person: Termination

Second Offense

- Bus to Object: 3pts and Saturday training
- Bus to Vehicle: 3pts, Saturday training, and Core Management counseling

Third Offense

Bus to Object: HR ReviewBus to Vehicle: HR Review

After a certain time (6months/1 year), a set amount of points can drop off after no accidents within this period, similar to points on your license.

After review, Cassandra offered her thoughts that we are in the right direction but we need to decide which it will be: offenses or a point system, not both. We also need to decide on an annual review/drop off for points.
