Line Checks will count as a major grade. You must have your lines memorized word for word of the script. If you don't know how to pronounce a certain word that your character speaks, make sure you look it up. Also, if you don't understand a word that your character speaks, look up the definition of the word.

- Scenes 1-5 (Wednesday, September 25th)
